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## Health Canada Legislation

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In 1993, the Royal Commission on New Reproductive Technologies issued a report that called on the Government of Canada to ban activities such as payment for sperm or eggs, commercial surrogacy and human cloning. In response, the Government of Canada established Assisted Human Reproduction Canada (AHRC). As Canada's federal regulatory agency, AHRC promotes the health, safety, dignity, and rights of Canadians who use Assisted Human Reproduction technologies.

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## Authorization

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I acknowledge that in accordance with Health Canada's legislation, I will only be receiving reimbursement for expenses associated with the egg donation process and that I will verify a list of said expenses by providing receipts for the expenses after my egg retrieval procedure by way of Egg Helpers current receipt management program.

**NOTE:** a request for reimbursement of expenses cannot be made until you have been selected by intended parents to be their egg donor.

These expenses include, but are not limited to mileage, parking, meals, vitamins, feminine toiletries, lost wages, childcare, note-takers, hotel accommodations and travel expenses.
